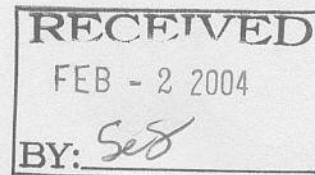

As a result of our sample audit performed August 21, 2003, your facility at 1800 NE 25th Avenue # 18, Hillsboro, Oregon is considered suitably equipped to perform testing on military devices for the following tests methods, all conditions unless otherwise noted, of MIL-STD-202:

Method: 101D Salt Spray
103B Humidity
106F Moisture resistance
107F Thermal Shock
201A Vibration
204D Vibration, High Frequency
213B Shock (specified pulse) Conditions A, G, J, and K.
214A Random Vibration

This suitability is valid until terminated by written notification from the qualifying activity. The normal period of suitability is two years from the date of the audit. If warranted, laboratory suitability may be withdrawn by this Center at any time. Your laboratory may be re-audited on a drop-in basis at any time.


This suitability prohibits your company from removing or altering device marking. Any device, which fails testing conditions, shall be identified (isolated) as a reject for verification of failure mode.

The approved test methods and procedures shall be used for all military testing.
